



## ACTION TAKEN FROM THE FEEDBACK OF BALAWAN COLLEGE ALUMNI, STUDENTS, EMPLOYERS AND TEACHERS FEEDBACK FORM 2023-23

### Action taken from the feedback form of Alumni:

1. Suggestion for a place to get rest during off period: The College has decided to split the tin roof conference room and convert it into common rooms for boys and girls. Students can take rest and relax during off period in the common rooms.



2. More Academic Courses: With regards to more academic courses, the college administration has applied to NEHU to upgrade elective subjects i.e., History and Economics to honour subjects. The same has been granted by NEHU and it will come into effect from academic year 2023-24.

3. Toilet: The toilet has been upgraded. The First floor was constructed this year to accommodate more users. The toilet in the ground floor is being used by boys and the newly constructed toilet in the first floor will be used by girls.



4. Drinking Water: Based on the feedback of the Alumni, the college authorities decided to buy two more 2000 litres syntexes to store water. Rain water harvesting has been done so that there is less scarcity of water. Two 1000 litres syntexes were installed in the terrace where water purification is being done following accepted procedures.



5. Smart Classroom: Based on Suggestion one classroom is converted into smart classroom where teachers can make use for digital classes and ICT. Teachers and students can make use of it for advance teaching and learning.



6. Computer Lab: Based on the suggestions, the college acquired 10 computers this year exclusively for the use of the students. Since the college lacks classroom, the computer lab is established in St. Michael's Institute of Vocational Education (SMIVE). Students can join the short term course on DTP for free of cost for this year.



## Action taken from the Feedback of Employers

1. Suggestion on NET qualified Teachers, Ph.D and Research: The College has encouraged the teachers to appear and clear NET as soon as possible. The time limit of two years has been set for them to clear NET. Balawan College encourage teachers to enrol themselves for higher studies. Three of the teachers have enrolled themselves for Ph. D in different universities.

## Action taken from the Feedback of Students

1. Drinking Water: This is dealt with in the suggestion no. 4 of the Alumni.
2. Common Room: Based on the suggestion, the tin roof common rooms have been repaired. The old tin was replaced by the new ones.



3. Toilet and Water: Improvements have been made with the toilets and water connection to the toilet has been re-done. Since water harvesting is being done, there is sufficient water for the students to use. Refer no. 4 of Alumni suggestion. Bucket is being provided in the toilets.



4. Infrastructure: The college is trying its best to improve the infrastructure. This year with the help of MLA scheme, the classroom extension was made possible. The college is improving with the principal's room being under construction.
5. Electricity in the classroom: Electricity has been connected to all the classrooms. Besides in every classroom there is one emergency bulb which helps when there is load shedding or when there is power failure.



## Action taken from the Feedback of Teachers

1. Black Board: The college is ordering new sets of Green Board for the use in the classrooms.
2. Green Plants: Green plants in the pots have been installed in the verandas.
3. Books and Journals: The librarians have been instructed to get suggestions of books and journals from the teachers and order to be placed for those books and journals.
4. ICT: One classroom is being allotted for the smart classroom and a projector was installed. A laptop of the college is available in the office for the use of the teachers especially for teaching with the help of ICT.



5. Maternity Leave: The management is still in the process to form the college handbook and college policy. However, the college permits the faculty to employ a substitute during the early age of pregnancy and maternity leave.
6. College Canteen: The college canteen was constructed and it is being run by the Alumni of the college. However facilities are still wanting in the canteen.



7. Separate Common Rooms for Boys and Girls: This is being dealt with in suggestion 1 of the Alumni.

8. Separate washrooms for ladies and gents teachers: This will take into effect once the principal room is ready and there will be separate staffroom and washrooms for ladies and gents.
9. Duster: Mr. Helpingstone Pariong donateed 10 dusters to the college for the welfare of the staff and the students.
